



CUTTING

Whether it's cutting annealed jumbo sheets of glass with our automatic cutting tables or producing delicate shapes utilising our state of the art specialist cutting equipment, we have the capability and capacity to cut glass to virtually any size or shape required.



EDGEWORK

Edgework is an important step in glass processing. It delivers not only aesthetics, but underpins the glass' performance and standards of safety. Our capability and experience can produce a wide range of edge finishes including cleancut, arrised, flat grind, flat polish or CNC polished edges.



HOLES, NOTCHES AND CUT-OUTS

Shower screens, balustrades ans splashbacks are just a few common applications that require holes, notches or cut-outs.

We produce holes including slotted and countersunk holes; notches including corner and side notches; any cut-outs - while we can produce in any thickness of glass to any shape or size, there are a few rules that you'll find on our website.



TOUGHENING

Toughening is an essential part of glass processing which not only increases the strength of the glass, but also enhances its thermal resistance and ability to withstand higher wind and weight loads.

CUSTOM LAMINATING

Laminated glass is manufactured by permanently bonding two or more pieces of annealed or heat treated glass together with specialist interlayers during a carefully managed heat and pressure process in either an autoclave or non-autoclave laminating oven. Either process ensures that the glass permanently adheres to the interlayer and helps to keep the integrity of the laminated piece of glass intact, even if subsequently cracked or broken.



INSULATED GLASS UNITS

Insulated glass units (IGUs) incorporates two (or more) pieces of glass which are bonded to a spacer and separated by a hermetically sealed air or gas filled space.

We produce for residential and commercial applications with Australia's largest maximum IGU size of up to 6000mm x 3210mm.
